History

In 2018, Patrick Mangan, the musical director of Riverdance, and Jennifer Licko, Celtic album of the year songwriter, teamed up to create Highland Echoes. Their goal was to showcase Scottish arts with the same level of energy and excitement that Riverdance brought to Irish arts. The debut show, featuring only four dancers and five musicians, left a crowd of 400+ at the Duke Energy Center Memorial AuditoriumDuke Energy Center for the Performing Arts spellbound.

Since then, Highland Echoes has grown in both size and spirit. Today, the show features 14-25 dancers and original compositions that highlight the power of the Great Highland Bagpipes and the haunting tones of Celtic melodies. The show has received glowing reviews for its captivating performances.

In addition, Jennifer Licko, the Producer, has more than twenty years of experience as a soloist on the school show circuit, where she educated students with Scottish cultural arts programming. This inspired her to offer an educational option for Highland Echoes performances, making it the perfect show for cultural & educational enrichment in addition to pure entertainment.

General Rider

Advertising and Promotion

Billing on all advertising and publicity must appear as follows: **“Highland Echoes”**

PREMISES agrees to use only artwork, ad mats, photos and/or promotional materials provided or approved by ARTIST in all advertisements. No product, service, or publication utilizing the name or likeness of ARTIST may be produced, sold, or distributed without the prior written consent of ARTIST.

PREMISES agrees not to commit ARTIST to any personal appearances, interviews or other promotion or appearance without prior written consent from ARTIST.

PREMISES agrees that there shall be no signs, placards or other advertising materials on or near the stage during the entire performance; nor shall any such advertising appear on tickets, flyers, handbills, or posters without the prior consent of ARTIST; nor shall the ARTIST appearance be sponsored by or in any other way tie-in with, any political candidate, commercial product or business.

ARTIST retains rights and control over corporate concert sponsorship and/or tour sponsorship. In the event a tour sponsorship is added at any time before or after contracting is completed, it is understood that PREMISES will make the best efforts to incorporate the tour sponsor's name, logo, and other requirements to the venue website henceforth.

ARTIST will send press releases about the event to local papers and media contacts in the area unless otherwise instructed. ARTIST will provide graphic assets as an .eps file (unless another file type is requested) for promotional use.

Ticketing

PREMISES will manage all ticket sales and make ticket buyers' emails available to ARTIST to provide freebies and excitement leading up to the event.

PREMISES managing ticket sales will HOLD 10 seats for VIPs which will be managed and controlled by ARTIST.

ARTIST will place a ticketing link on the Highland Echoes website.

ARTIST has the right to communicate with ticket buyers via email to provide information, special updates, and bonuses to enhance the overall Highland Echoes experience.

Sound Requirements

See ARTIST technical rider.

PREMISES will contact ARTIST to make arrangements for an agreed-upon arrival time.

ARTIST shall have the right to provide a Bagpiper performing outside of the venue 30 minutes

prior to show time.

Recording

ARTIST reserves the right to record the show. All other forms of recording, including audio, video, television, radio and all forms of digital recording are forbidden without prior written permission from ARTIST for each occasion.

Parking

Parking should be provided by the PREMISES at no cost to the Highland Echoes company close to the loading dock.

Performance

The Highland Echoes performance will consist of two 55 minute acts with a 15-20 minute intermission. For the performance time of other shows please see chart on page one.

Accommodation

PREMISES must provide comfortable and safe accommodation at a hotel or airB&B no further than 15 miles from the performance venue.

7 rooms - Highland Echoes Pocket Show

10 rooms - Holiday Show

15 rooms - Highland Echoes Show

No accommodation needed - The Highland Echoes School Shows

Merchandise

An area of the lobby or other suitable place should be set aside for sales of Highland Echoes merchandise.

At least one table is required for this. ARTIST shall have sole and exclusive merchandising rights. If PREMISES takes a merchandise percentage on the night of the event, then PREMISES will provide a premise staff member to be at the merchandise table for and manage all sales. All merchandise will be marked up from the retail price.

Dressing Room/Bathrooms

The ARTIST needs two (only one needed for pocket shows and school shows) dressing rooms with space for hanging costumes. A quick change (pipe and drape is fine) may be needed backstage depending on the distance to the dressing rooms.

Catering

PREMISES agrees to provide bottled water, deli tray, and fruit for the Highland Echoes Company 2 hours prior to show time. For school Shows no catering is needed.

Security

Please ensure at all times that the stage, dressing rooms and mix position are off limits and secure.

Deposit

A 50% deposit is required at least 30 days before the show date.

Tech Rider

Lighting

ARTIST will provide a cue sheet at least 60 days prior to the show. ARTIST will provide gobos for the floor designs. No special lighting is needed for school shows.

PREMISES will provide the lighting tech and have all lights set prior to ARTIST arrival.

Sound

PREMISES will provide the sound equipment and backline. (email info@highlandechoes.com for the full technical specs) No Backline is needed for Pocket shows and School shows.

Stage

Stage size: MINIMUM 24' X 26'

PREMISES will provide a stage without Marley.

PREMISES will provide risers according to the technical rider and have risers set up and ready upon ARTIST's arrival. No risers are needed for School Shows.

PREMISES will provide projection tech. No projection is needed for School Shows.
